- **Polyester or Vinyl Headband?** The downside of vinyl is that it could start to crack when exposed over time to the sun and high heat. The downside of a polyester headband is that it can get dirty and is hard to clean.
- **Benefit of the top 6 rows having double mesh?** The top 6 rows receive the most use/abuse, therefore the double mesh/netting will add to the longevity of the net.
- **Benefit of a tapered net?** When a net is tapered, it means that the bottom tape is tapered at the center. This prevents excess bottom tape from dragging and rubbing on the surface. Tapering will add to the longevity of the tennis net.
